Q: I usually bring back wine from my vacation. This November I'll be going to Montreal. Can you recommend any particular wine to look for? I know Canada doesn't export a lot of its wine to the States. I'm not a big fan of dessert wine, but any other recommendation would be appreciated. -- Marie Cummins, Chicago

A: Too bad about the dessert wine, because Canada's Niagara region is home to some killer ice wines, in which golden sweetness is balanced by a crisp acidity and a toothsome mouth feel. That said, why not try some of Niagara's other varietals? **I'd be interested in trying the table wines produced by Inniskillin, whose ice wine is among the world's best.** Or, consider exploring some wines from the Okanagan Valley of British Columbia. Have fun exploring; let me know what you find
